

Department Structure



 - Formation of Technical Working Group







BUDGET REPORT FOR 2019



Total Budget for 2019 is VT 25,495,777 and the total expenses to date is VT 19,596,216.

DoCC main expenses are its bills (Elec.), travelling expenses, purchase of office furniture and assets and other activities.

DoCC has a surplus of payroll due to late recruitment of staffs.

This surplus has been transferred to operations via Virement that was submitted on QTY 3 to complete 2019 work plan.


