Adaptation:


Adjustment in natural or human systems in response to actual or expected climatic stimuli or their effects, which moderates harm or exploits beneficial opportunities.

Disaster Risk Management (DRM)

The systematic management of organizations, resources, skills and abilities to reduce disaster risk and alleviate the impacts of hazards and related disasters.





The work of CCDRM

- Enable and facilitate research into vulnerabilities
- Promote the use of and disseminate CC & DRM informations
- Centralize and make available CCDRM informations
- Mainstream key CC/DRM messages in NAB-Endorsed reports, educational materials, sector policies and work plans
- Establish & Maintain Database related to CCDRM strategies (Includes; Location, effectiveness, lesson learn)
- Support CCDRM implementations WITH NAB stakeholders
- Support NAB on CCDRM initiatives in Vanuatu

NB: Coordinate, Implement and provide Advisories to key stakeholders

Planned Activities

- Establish relationship and networks with the key stakeholders
- Signing of MOU with respective implementing partners, and others
- Building networks for future engagements
- Liaise with key stakeholders to effect national policy implementations align with Adaptation
